

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LEGEND

ITEM $1 = M6 \times 80 \text{mm}$ LONG COUNTERSUNK BOLT (x1).

ITEM 2 = CLAMP SPACER (S0928) (x1).

ITEM 3 = CARBON LEVER GUARD (LG0006COMP).

ITEM 4 = CONE SPACER (S0781) (x1).

ITEM 5 = EXPANDING SPACER (S0569) (x1).

ITEM 6 = TAPERED NUT (H0032) (x1).

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Set of Allen keys to include 4mm A/F.
- Whatever tools required to remove original bar-end if applicable.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the Lever Guard (item 2) remove the original bar end.
- Place the counter-sunk bolt (Item 1) through the clamp spacer (Item 2) and then through the Lever Guard (Item 3) so the flat face of the spacer sits against the front face of the lever guard as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Insert the cone spacer (Item 4) through the protruded end of the bolt so the spacer sits inside the lever guard.
- Insert the Expander (Item 5) through the protruded end of the bolt, follow by the tapered nut (Item 6). Ensure that the tapered nut sits in the expander. Do not fully tighten the nut into the expander at this stage.
- Offer the whole assembly into the handle-bar until the expanding spacer (Item 5) sits against the face of the handle-bar tube.
- Position the lever guard so when the handle bar is at full lock in both directions it does not make any contact with any other part of the motorcycle.
- Fully tighten the bolt and check operation.

IMPORTANT:- WHEN FITTING THIS PRODUCT IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT THE PRODUCT IN NO WAY IMPEDES THE OPERATION OF THE MOTORCYCLE AND IS CHECKED REGULARLY FOR TIGHTNESS AND OPERATION.

FAILURE TO CHECK THE ABOVE COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DAMAGE.



OUTILS REQUIS

- Jeu de clés Allen 4mm.
- Quelconque outil pour enlever l'extrémité d'origine du guidon

NOTICE DE MONTAGE

- Pour monter le Garde levier (article 2), enlever l'extrémité d'origine du guidon.
- Placer le boulon (article 1) dans le Garde levier.
- Placer l'entretoise d'extension (article 3) sur le filetage et sur le Garde levier de façon à ce que le diamètre le plus large se place contre le Garde levier.
- Placer l'écrou (article 4) sur le filetage et engagez jusqu'à ce qu'il se place dans l'écarteur tout juste monté.
- Placer l'ensemble dans le guidon et en position de façon à ce que le garde ne puis en aucun cas toucher une autre partie de la moto lorsque le guidon est verrouillé au maximum d'un coté ou de l'autre de la moto.
- Serrer complètement le boulon puis vérfier le fonctionnement.

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


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
